VI. Reports

1. At the June 3, 2026 CareerSource Florida Board of Directors meeting, Workforce Policy G103 – Performance Requirements for Local Workforce Development Boards (Revised) was approved. This state level Administrative policy makes changes to how boards are held accountable for performance. Staff will provide a more in-depth report on the changes and what that means for the region and the workforce system as a whole.

VII. New Business

1. Consideration to approve placing the Youth Committee under the One Stop Committee as a subcommittee

Currently youth “framework” services, outreach, recruitment, eligibility, and case management, are delivered through the one-stop career centers by youth case managers. If youth are appropriate for training or GED they are referred to appropriate training providers. Training services are not delivered by one-stop staff. The Youth Committee’s work is closely connected to the services, systems, and partnerships already overseen by the One-Stop Committee. Youth programming relies on the same operational structure that supports adult and dislocated worker services. Because of this natural alignment, placing the Youth Committee under the One-Stop Committee would create a clearer, more streamlined governance structure.
