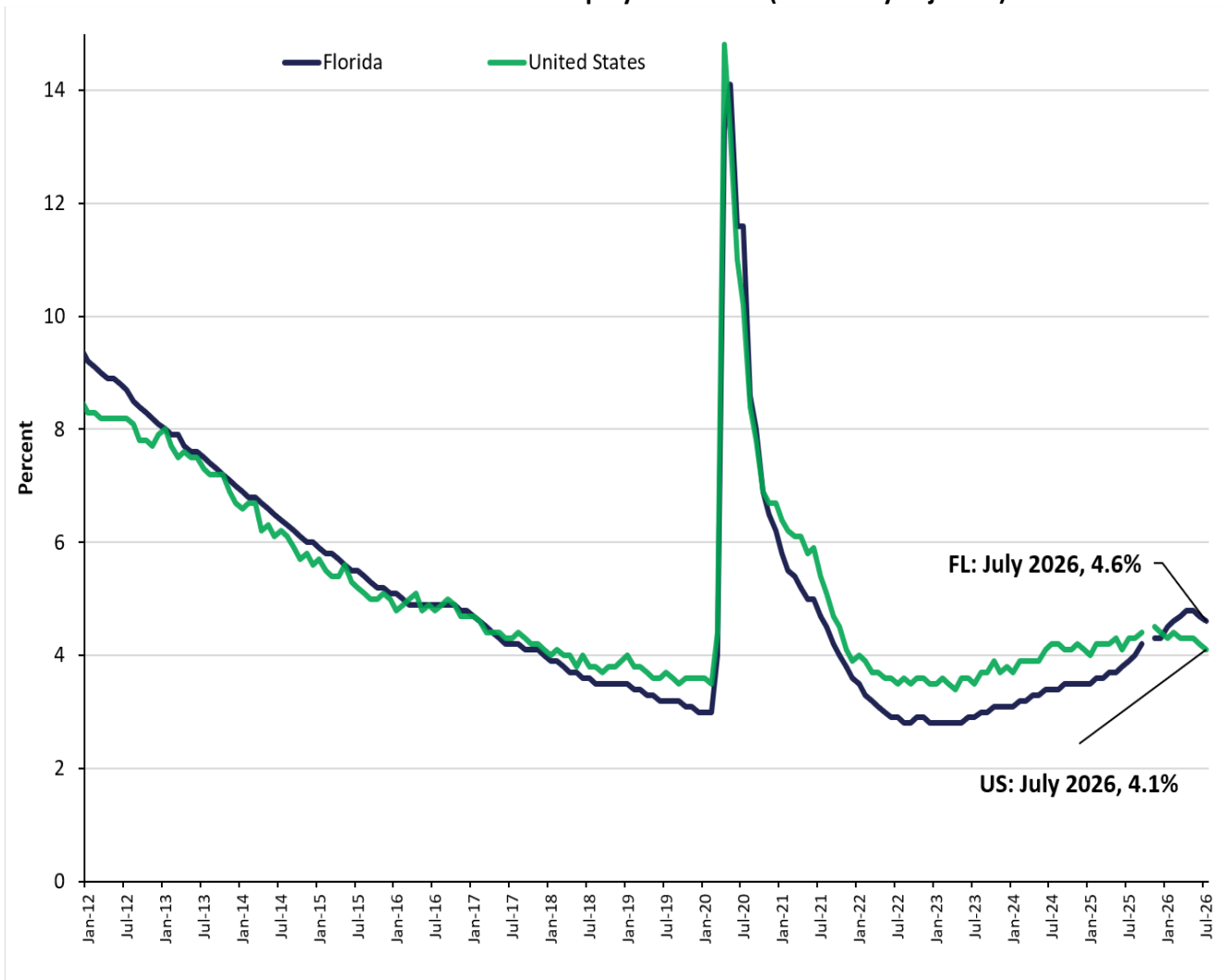
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### Florida's July Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.6 percent in July 2026, down 0.1 percentage point from 4.7 percent in June 2026, and up 0.7 percentage point from a year ago. There were 515,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,121,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in July.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 10,037,300 in July 2026, an increase of 4,500 jobs (less than +0.1 percent) over the month. The state gained 41,000 jobs over the year, an increase of 0.4 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 0.2 percent over the year.

## Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Six of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in July.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were education and health services (+35,800 jobs, +2.2 percent), professional and business services (+13,600 jobs, +0.8 percent), leisure and hospitality (+13,200 jobs, +1.0 percent), manufacturing (+4,200 jobs, +1.0 percent), trade, transportation, and utilities (+3,800 jobs, +0.2 percent), and construction (+2,700 jobs, +0.4 percent).
- The industries losing jobs over the year included financial activities (-13,600 jobs, -2.0 percent); total government (-13,100 jobs, -1.1 percent); information (-3,100 jobs, -2.0 percent); and other services (-2,600 jobs, -0.7 percent).

## Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In July 2026, Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.5 percent), followed by Monroe County (3.3 percent), and Wakulla County (4.2 percent).
- Taylor County had the highest unemployment rate (8.4 percent) in Florida in July 2026, followed by Sumter County (7.9 percent), and Union County (6.9 percent).

## Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In July 2026, 23 of all 25 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+16,500 jobs, +1.1 percent), followed by the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+10,800 jobs, +0.8 percent), the Tampa MD (+6,600 jobs, +0.6 percent), the Lakeland-Winter Haven MSA (+5,000 jobs, +1.8 percent), and the North Port-Bradenton-Sarasota MSA (+4,400 jobs, +1.2 percent).
- Two metro areas in Florida lost jobs over the year in July 2026, the Crestview-Fort Walton Beach-Destin MSA (-800 jobs, -0.6 percent) and the Fort Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Sunrise MD (-400 jobs, less than -0.1 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.

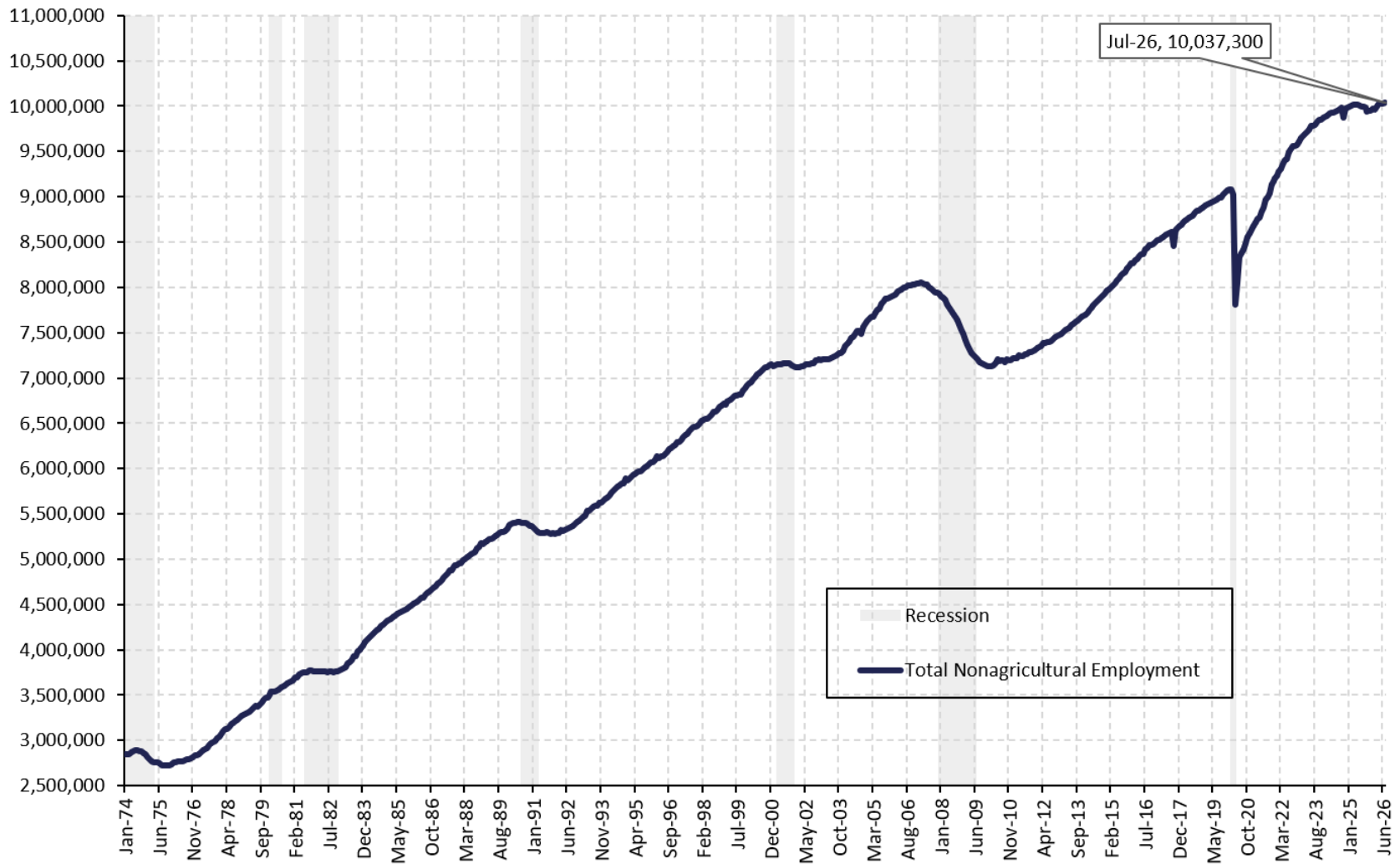

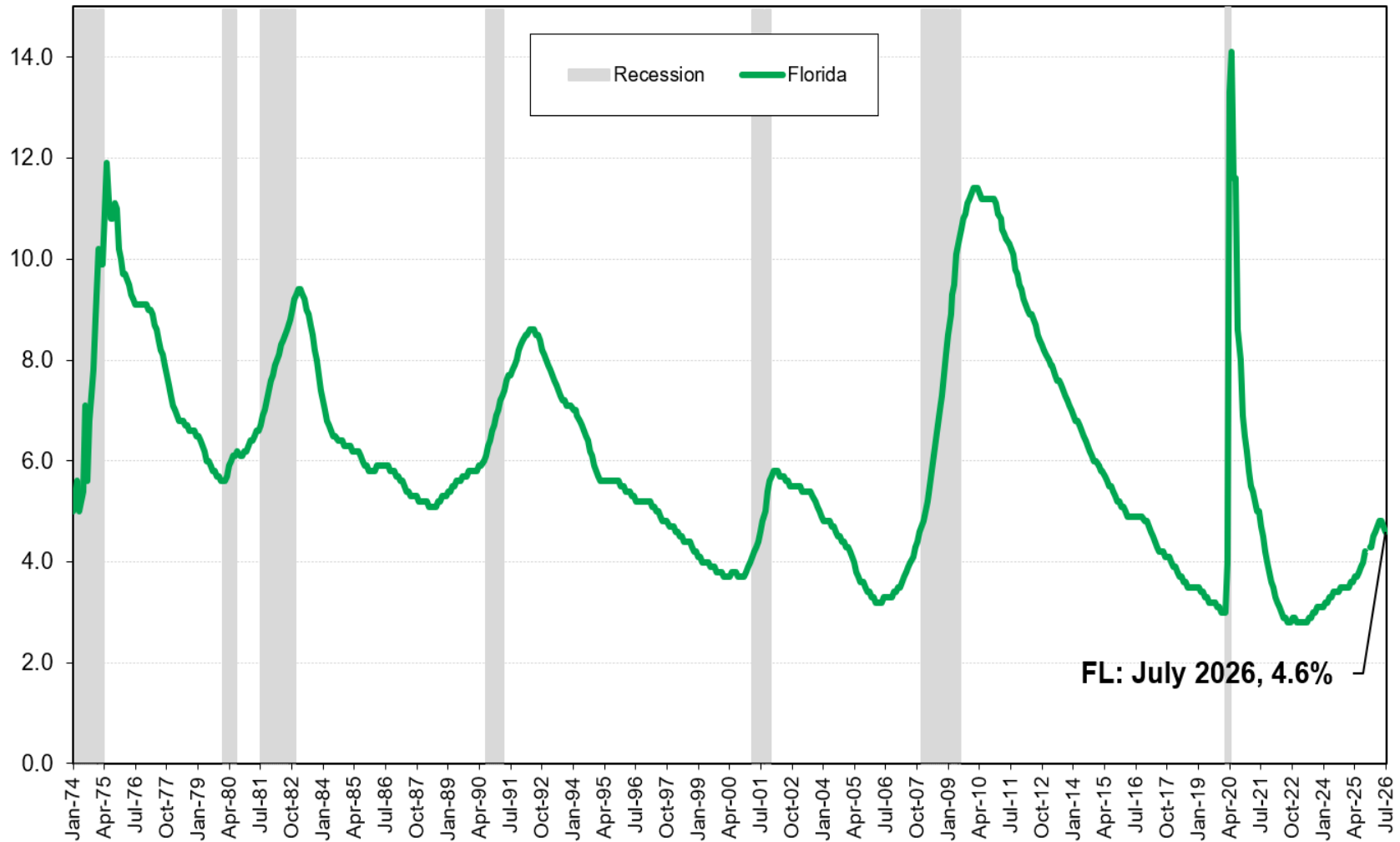

**January 1974 - July 2026**



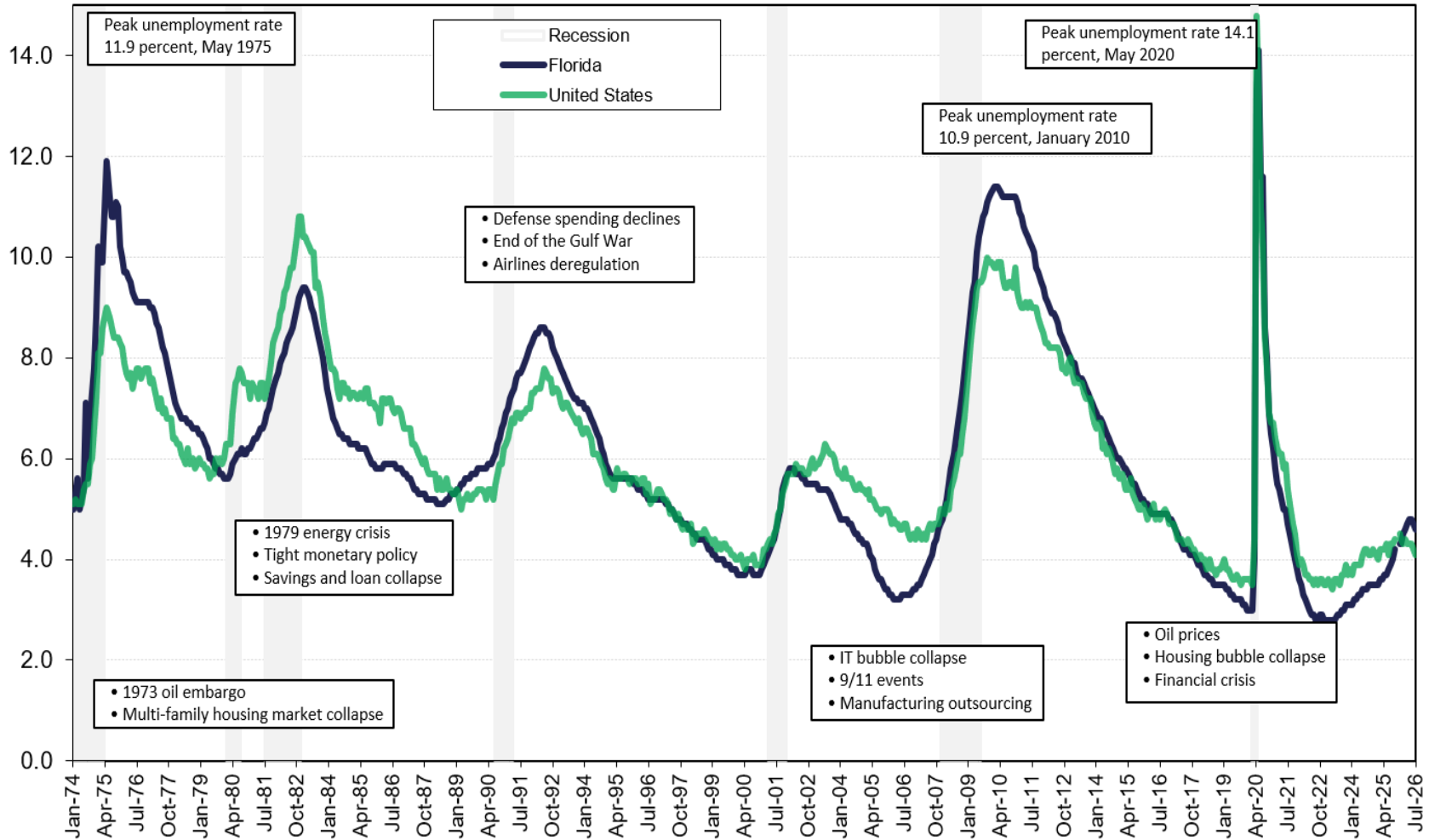

**January 1974 - July 2026**



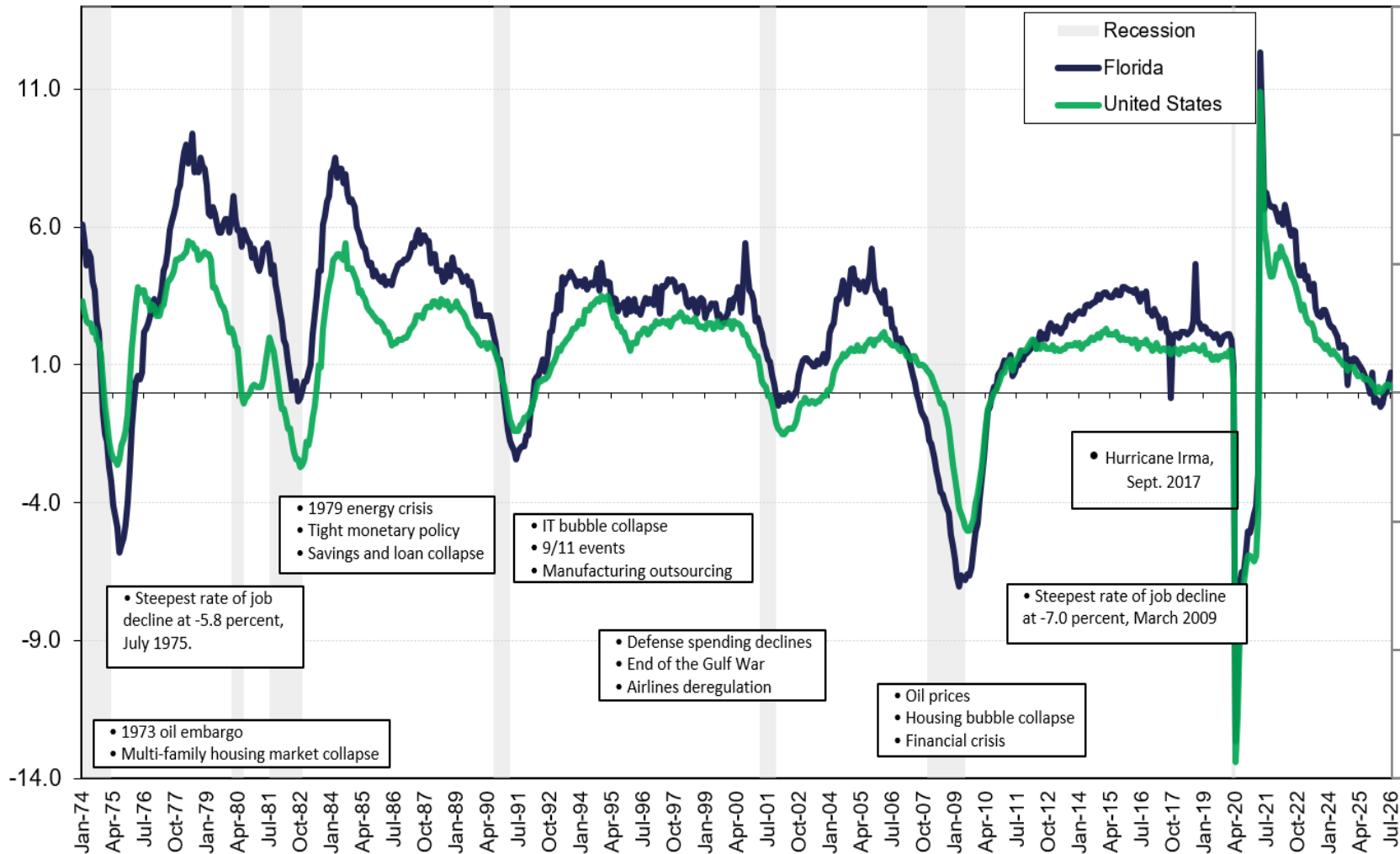

# Florida and the United States Unemployment Rates and Recessionary Periods January 1974 - July 2026



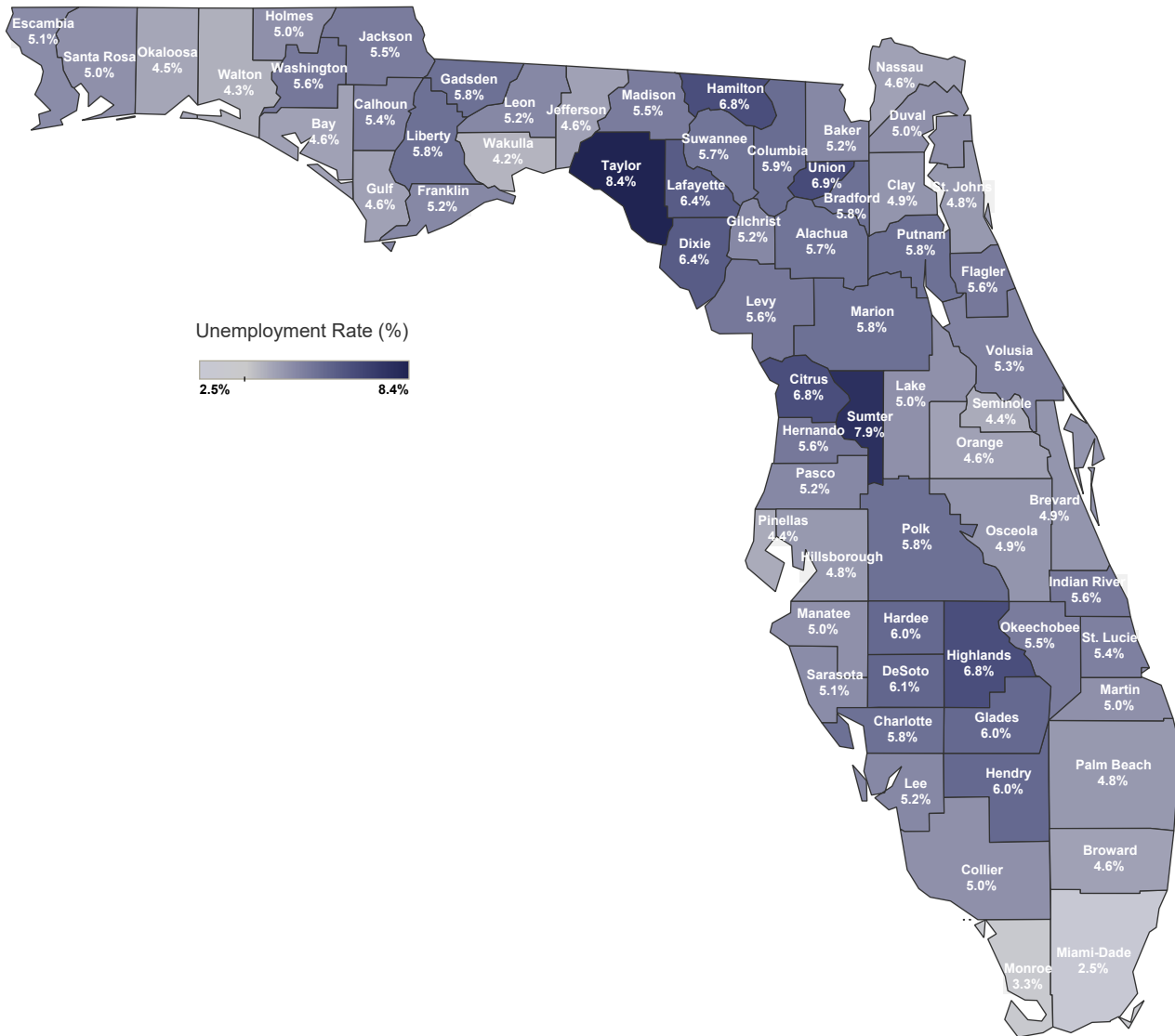
