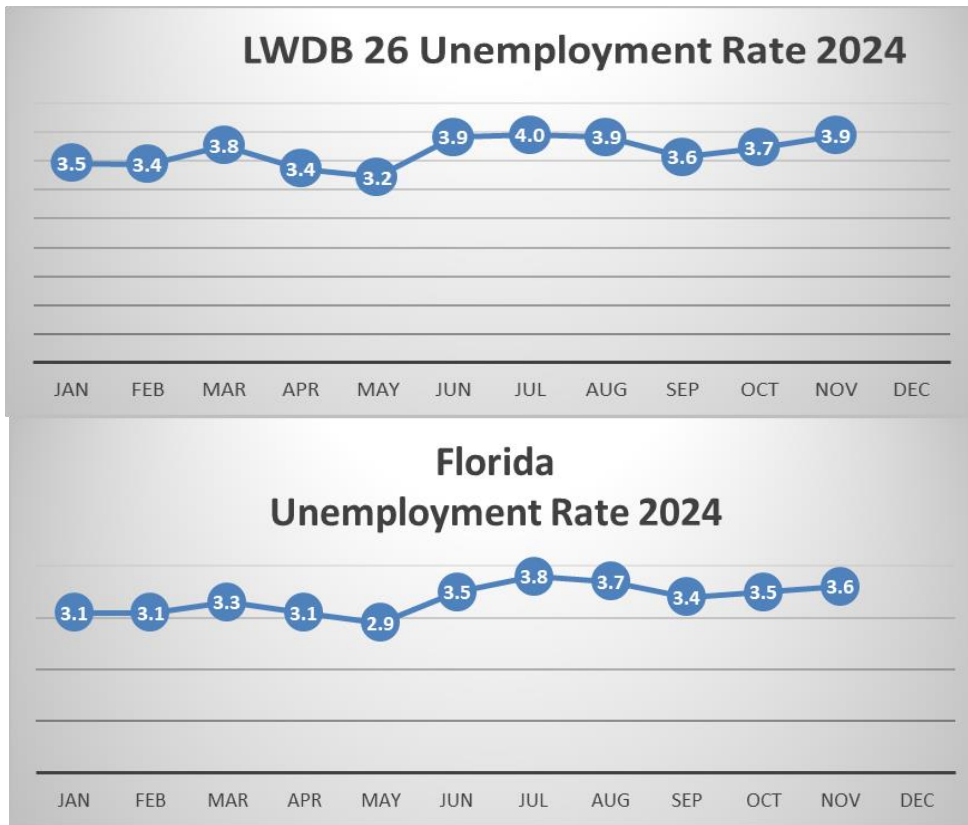
1. CEO and Consolidation Update

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3. CSNCFL Education and Industry Consortium

Florida Statutes requires each local workforce development board to create an education and industry consortium composed of representatives of educational entities and businesses in the designated workforce service delivery area. Local consortiums are required to meet quarterly and provide reports to the local workforce development board that includes community-based information related to educational programs and industry needs. Consortium reports inform the local workforce development board and staff on programs, services and partnerships in the service delivery area. Consortium members are recruited from local educational entities and businesses in the designated workforce



service delivery area and appointed by the CSNCFL Board Chair. Attached for informational purposes is the current roster.
