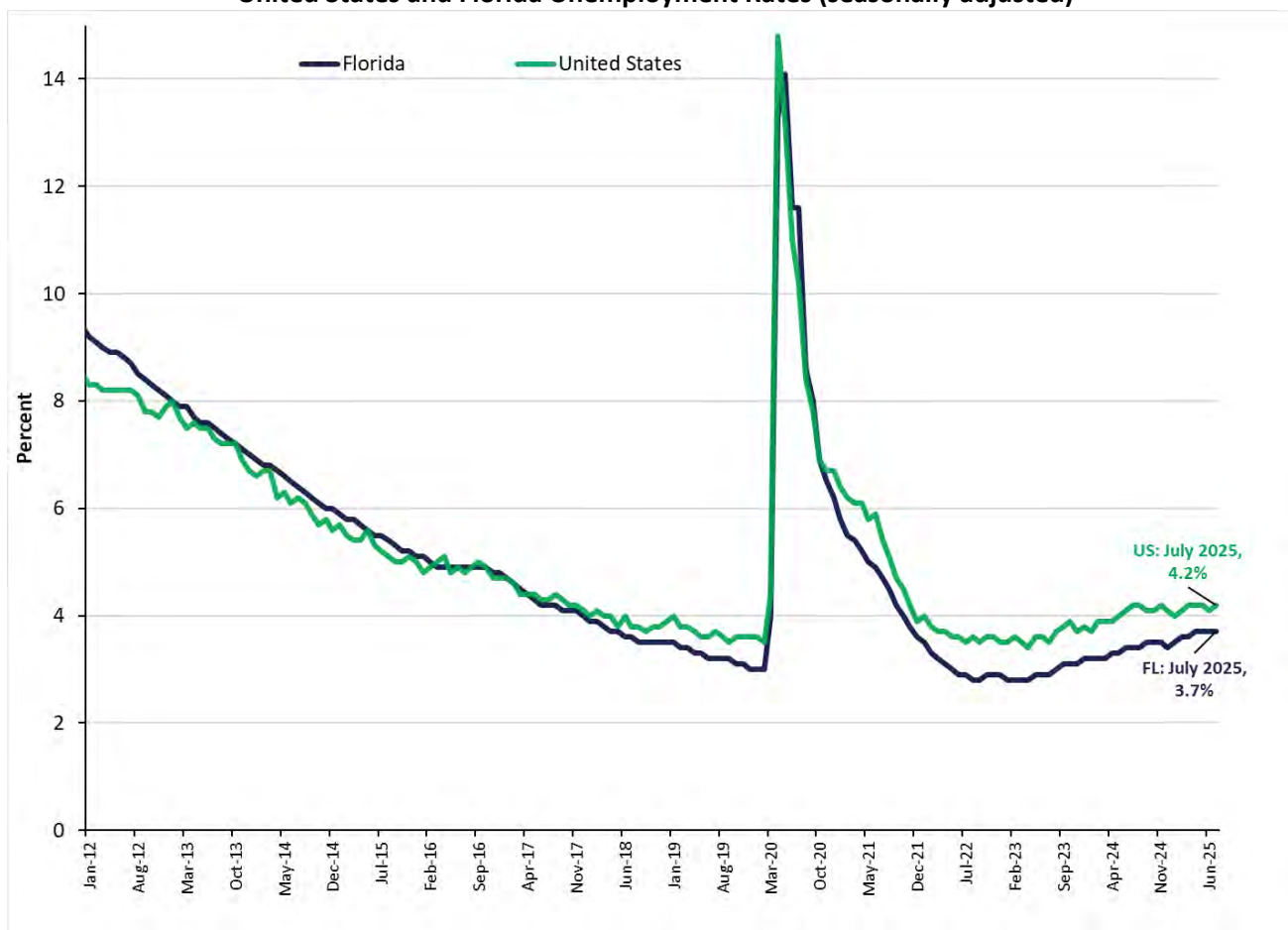
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Florida's July Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in July 2025, unchanged from the June 2025 rate, and up 0.3 percentage point from a year ago. There were 417,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,196,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in July.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 10,069,000 in July 2025, an increase of 7,300 jobs (+0.1 percent) over the month. The state gained 134,100 jobs over the year, an increase of 1.3 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.0 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Nine major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in July, and one major industry remained unchanged from a year ago.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+40,400 jobs, +2.6 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+29,600 jobs, +1.5 percent); leisure and hospitality (+18,100 jobs, +1.4 percent); total government (+15,200 jobs, +1.3 percent); professional and business services (+12,800 jobs, +0.8 percent); other services (+7,600 jobs, +2.0 percent); financial activities (+6,300 jobs, +0.9 percent); construction (+3,800 jobs, +0.6 percent); and manufacturing (+400 jobs, +0.1 percent).
- Information remained unchanged from a year ago.

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In July 2025, Monroe County and Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.8 percent each), followed by Wakulla County (3.5 percent).
- Sumter County had the highest unemployment rate (7.1 percent) in Florida in July 2025, followed by Taylor County (6.8 percent), and Citrus County and Glades County (6.2 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In July 2025, 22 of all 25 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+26,700 jobs, +1.8 percent), followed by the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+22,100 jobs, +1.7 percent), and the Tampa MD (+15,500 jobs, +1.5 percent).
- Three metro areas in Florida lost jobs over the year in July 2025. The areas losing jobs were the Crestview-Fort Walton Beach-Destin MSA (-1,600 jobs, -1.2 percent), the Panama City-Panama City Beach MSA (-1,500 jobs, -1.6 percent), and the Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent MSA (-200 jobs, -0.1 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.

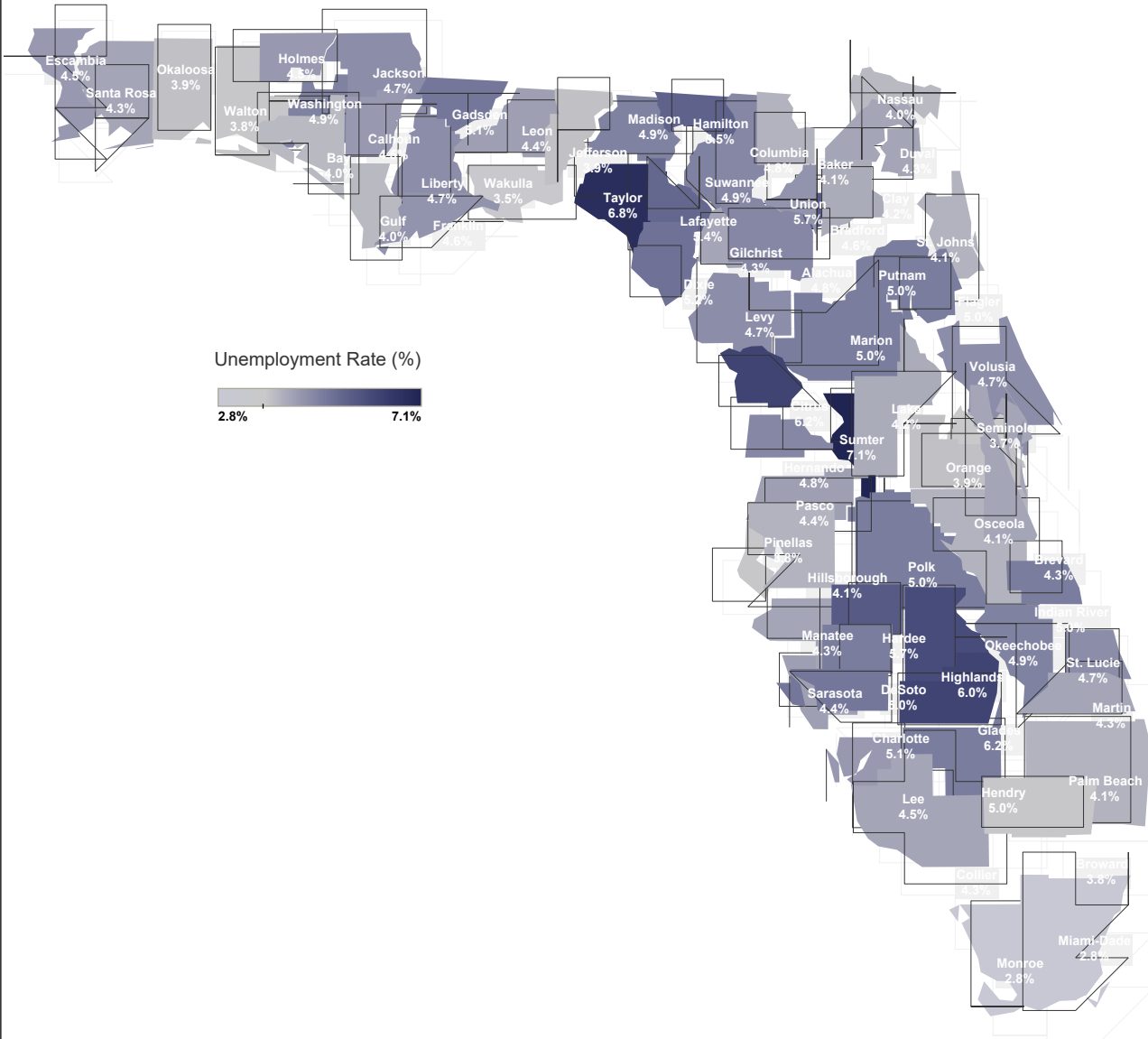

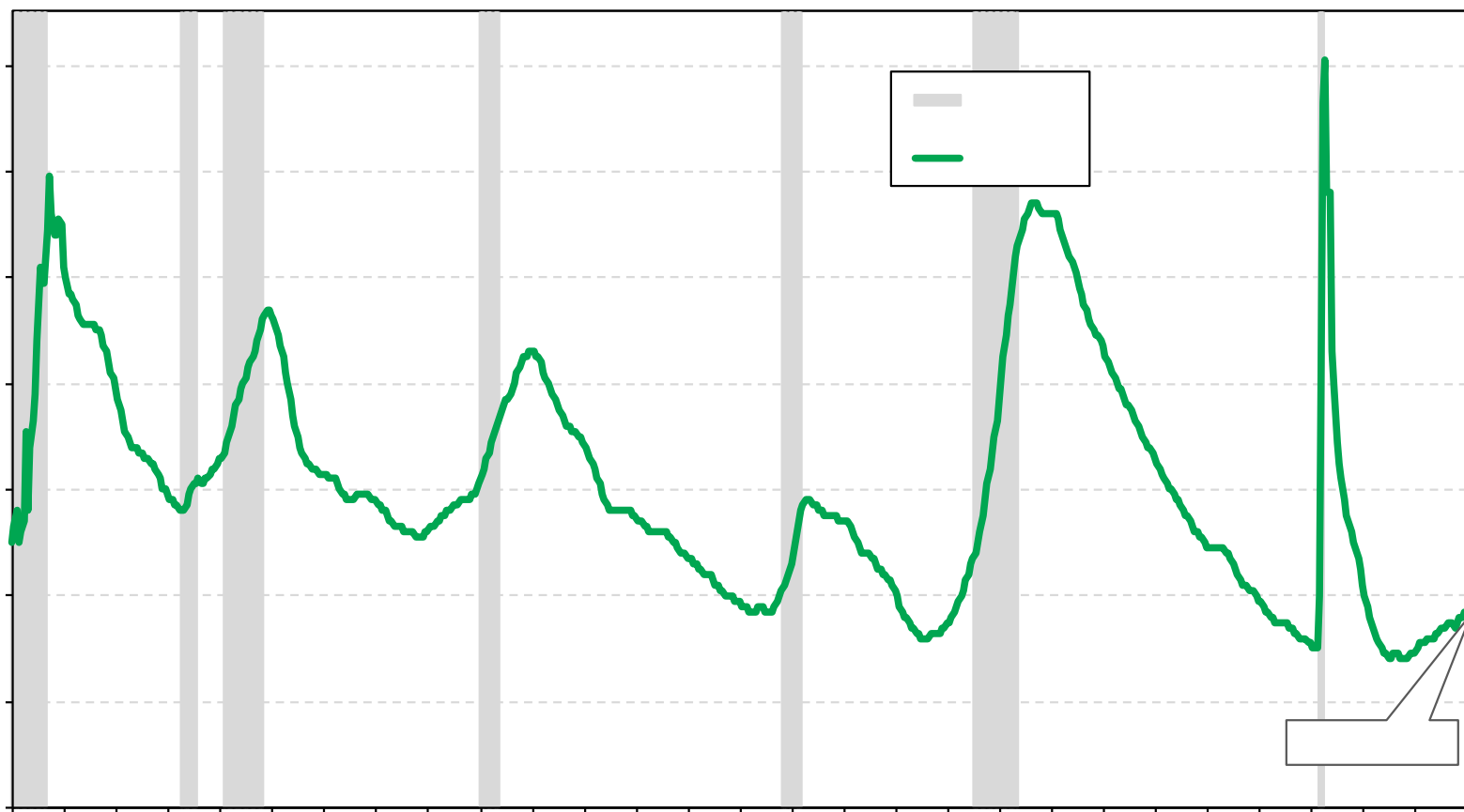

Florida Unemployment Rates by County (Not Seasonally Adjusted) July 2025



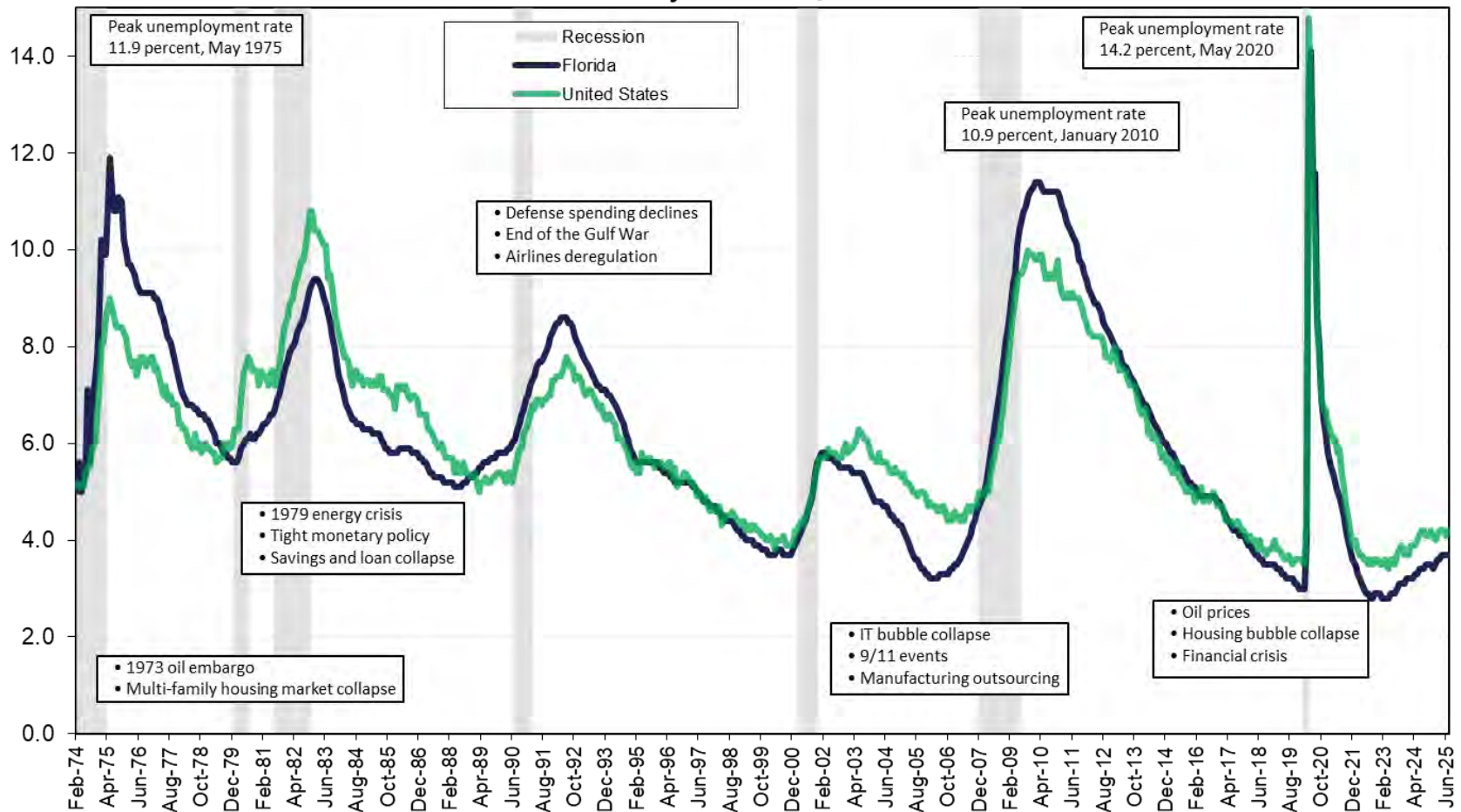

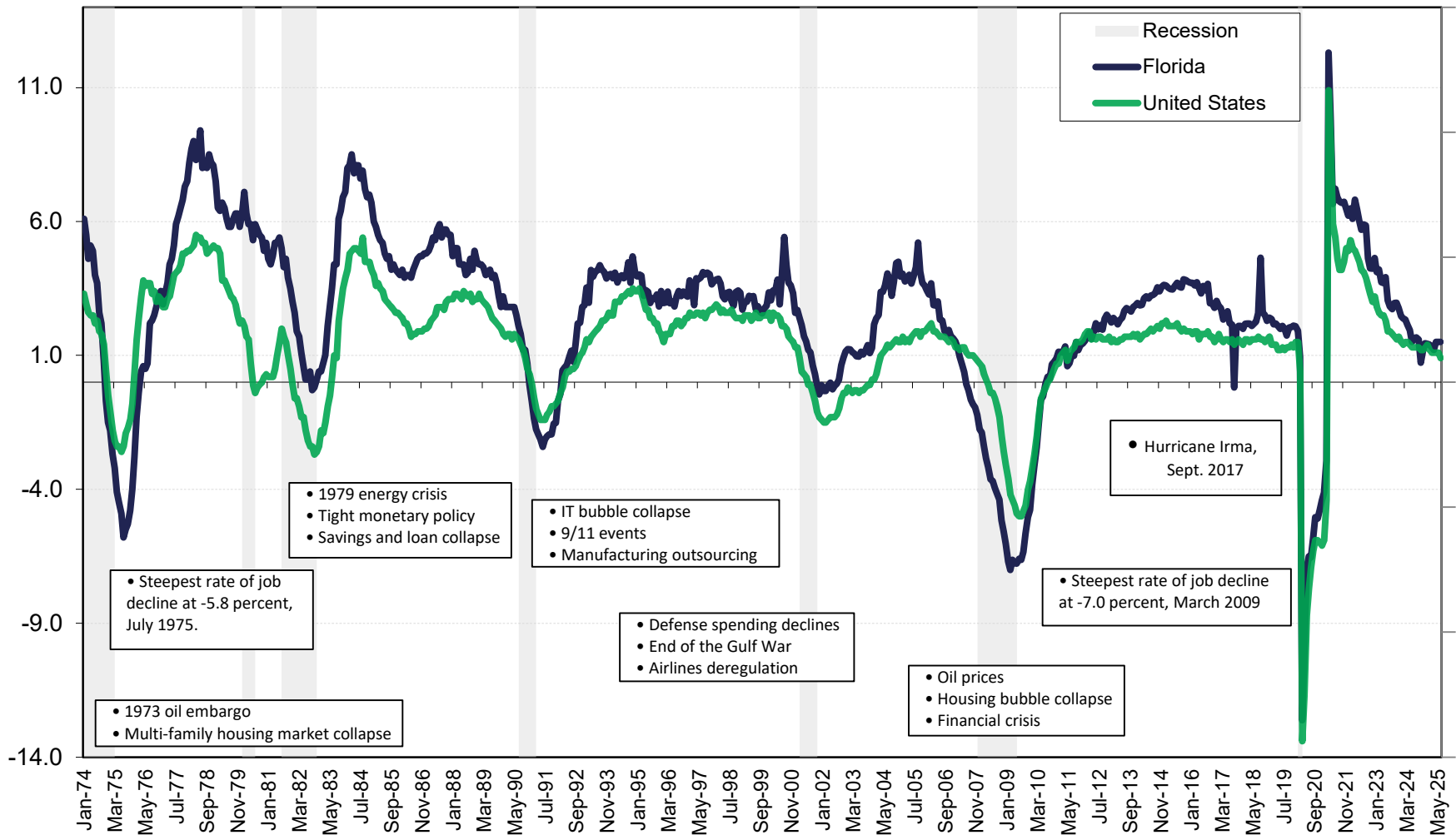

Florida and the United States Unemployment Rates and Recessionary Periods January 1974 - July 2025



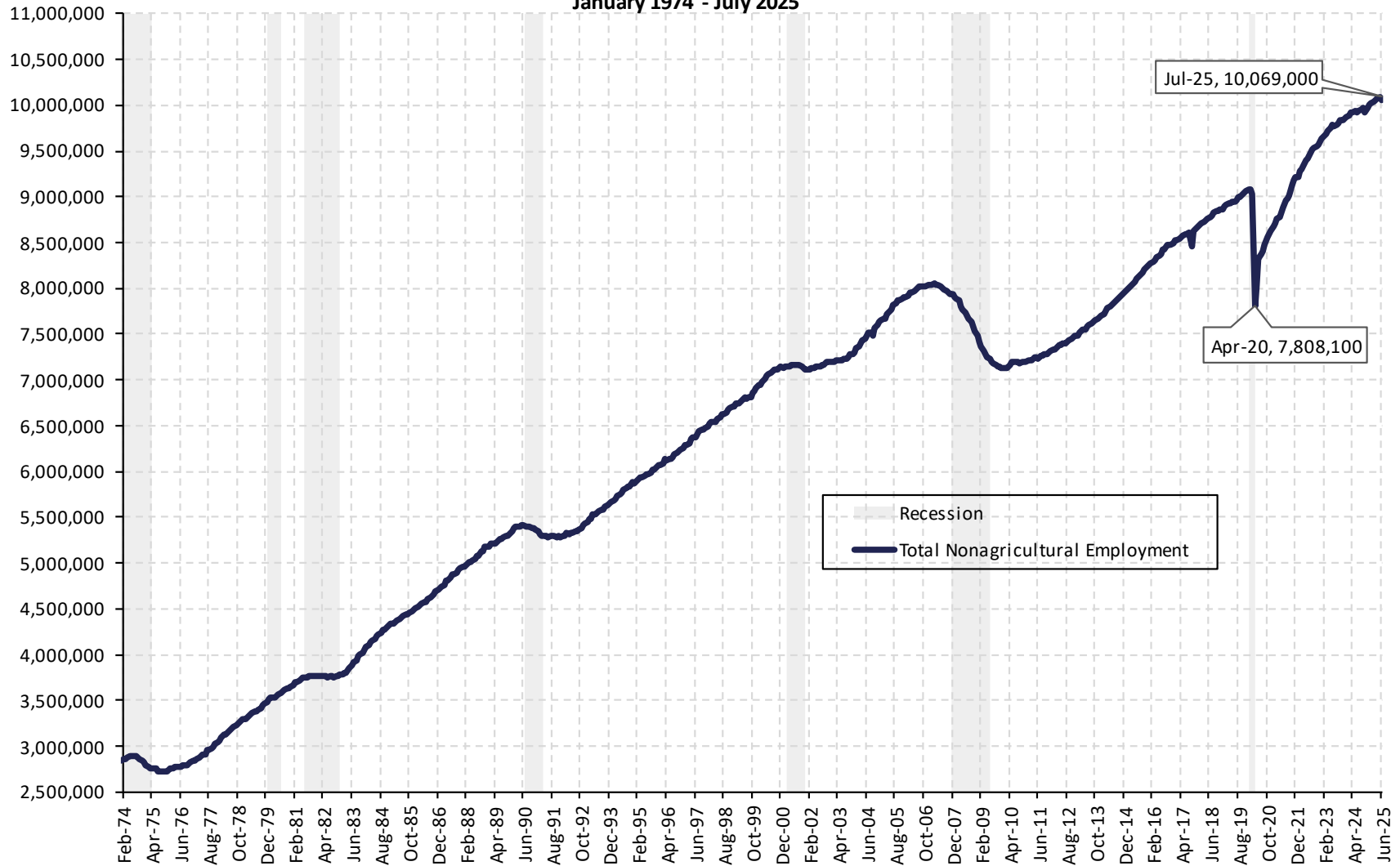
